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## THE PROBLEM

# 01

## Bullying has changed. Most school systems have not.

Bullying now operates across group chats, anonymous platforms, and AI-powered tools. A single screenshot can circulate to hundreds of students in minutes. A deepfake can fabricate evidence that never existed. Yet most school policies were written for a different era.

- Staff hesitate because they lack structured response protocols.
- Parents escalate publicly on WhatsApp groups before schools can respond.
- Awareness campaigns create posters, not change.
- Policies exist on paper but rarely translate into consistent daily practice.
- Digital incidents are under-documented because staff are unsure how to handle evidence.

## 02

### THE R4 FRAMEWORK

## Four pillars. One integrated system.

Built on four decades of peer-reviewed research (Olweus, KiVa, PBIS, Second Step) and extended for digital-age realities. The student curriculum spans ages 3–18 across three stages: Early Years (6 sessions), Primary (12 sessions), and Secondary (14 sessions).

### RECOGNISE

*Early Detection & Pattern Literacy*

Identify harmful behaviour before it escalates. Unified behaviour taxonomy, platform awareness matrix, three-level severity ladder, multi-channel reporting. Every report acknowledged within 24 hours.

### RESPOND

*Rapid, Consistent, Documented Action*

Contain harm quickly. 24-hour response protocol (0–2 hrs: safety check; 2–12 hrs: triage; 12–24 hrs: action plan). Role-based response model. Evidence preservation standards.

### RESTORE

*Repair, Rebuild, Reinforce*

Prevent trauma and recurrence. Target support plan with 6-week monitoring. Behaviour change plan for aggressors. Bystander reintegration. Restorative practice only when voluntary and safe.

### REDUCE RISK

*Environmental & Cultural Design*

Make bullying structurally difficult. Physical hotspot audits. Reality-based digital citizenship. Bystander norms training. Parent partnership with device agreements and escalation flowcharts.

# 03

## THE DIGITAL REALITY LAYER

### The cross-pillar overlay for a world the textbooks did not predict.

Built for the digital environment, not retrofitted to include it.

- Impersonation and identity theft across social platforms
- Deepfakes: fabricated images, video, and audio used to humiliate or blackmail
- Voice cloning technology used to create false evidence
- Fake screenshots and doctored images presented as proof
- Doxing and personal information exposure
- Pile-ons and coordinated group harassment
- AI-generated content designed to target specific students

**Annual update:** Reviewed every year. A static framework is a failed framework.

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### THE SEVERITY LADDER

Three levels. Each triggers specific, documented actions.

Level	Indicators	Triggers
<b>Level 1</b> Early Risk	Teasing, mild exclusion, subtle sarcasm	Pastoral note, pattern log, quiet check-in
<b>Level 2</b> Escalating Harm	Group targeting, screenshots, rumour spreading	Formal report, safeguarding review, action plan
<b>Level 3</b> High Risk	Threats, sexual content, blackmail, self-harm risk	Immediate intervention, safeguarding lead, external referral

## Where does your school stand?

Be honest. The value is in the gaps, not the scores.

### RECOGNISE

- Our staff can distinguish between conflict and bullying consistently.
- We have a shared definition of bullying that includes digital and AI-assisted harm.
- Students have multiple, stigma-free channels to report concerns.
- We track patterns across incidents, not just individual reports.

### RESPOND

- We have a documented response protocol with defined timeframes.
- Staff know exactly what to do in the first two hours after a report.
- We have clear evidence-handling procedures for digital incidents.
- Parents are notified within a consistent, documented timeline.

### RESTORE

- Every target receives a structured support plan, not just a check-in.
- We monitor outcomes for a minimum of six weeks after an incident.
- Restorative practices are offered only when the target consents voluntarily.
- We have a documented behaviour change plan for aggressors.

### REDUCE RISK

- We have audited physical and digital hotspots in the past 12 months.
- Our digital citizenship programme addresses real platforms, not generic safety tips.
- Parents receive structured guidance on device management and escalation.
- We review and update our bullying prevention systems annually.

**If you ticked fewer than half in any pillar, that pillar is a structural gap. Most schools score well on Recognise and poorly on Restore and Reduce Risk. This is normal — and fixable.**
